Vandalism to new toilets
After waiting for many years the old toilet block in the Village was finally replaced last year. However, over the weekend of 22nd/23rd May vandals poured concrete down the toilets. Carol-Anne Armitage, the Village Manager, says it simply defies explanation why anyone would do that. Due to budget constraints this block was one of only a few in Manukau City to be replaced last year. Manukau City Council will now have to repair them as two of the units are totally unusable. Not only will these repairs be costly but it will also create considerable inconvenience to the community, including the elderly, disabled and mothers with young children. Icon Security

With the onset of winter and the greater hours of darkness, the issue of lighting becomes very important for security purposes.

The criminal element looks for targets that provide concealment to their activities. This includes poor lighting, overgrown trees and shrubs and alleyways with areas of concealment. Steps you can take to improve your security include;

- Report faulty or non working street lamps to the appropriate authority
- Ensure that you have external lighting covering access points to your premise (ie front and rear doors and accessible windows). Lights that work on motion sensors can be very effective also
- Keep alleyways clear of rubbish and unnecessary items like empty pallets and
- Leave an internal light on overnight, particularly covering window frontage or valuable product items


