

Down on the Farm 2012

Summer is finally here, and thanks to all the rain we have had, we have loads of grass as well. Over the years we have been planting shade and shelter for our stock, which is starting to pay off. Unfortunately we have had a few issues with dogs over the summer break, our Pitt Island Ram died as a result of his injuries, as did 8 ewes. Dogs have also been in the Watercare Coastal walkway area causing havoc on the bird roosts and nesting sites for NZ Dotterel. The Watercare Bird Roosts are intended as an alternative place for wader birds to roost, to keep them away from Auckland Airport.

Recent developments at Ambury include the building of our long awaited hayshed, which will give

us back the space in our work shop and somewhere for our tractor to be parked inside. The big dip in our playing paddock has been filled with topsoil. The big dip had occurred due to the gas pipeline that runs through the farm from Marsden Point to Wiri.

The park has been really busy with families having get togethers, bbgs, playing volleyball, football, cricket, walking, camping and bike riding. Loads of tourists in their backpacker vans start and end their NZ adventure at Ambury.

February 12th we are hosting the Womens Dualthlon again, with the series finishing at Ambury on the 29th April. We are also looking forward to having a Young Farmers Careers day here, and a Workchoice Trust Careers' Day in the 1st term. School bookings are rolling in, with only a few days left in term one.

Early mornings at Ambury hear the chorus of whistling frogs; why not bring the family down for a night in a tent over the weekend?

Happy New Year to you all! We hope you have enjoyed the break, despite the unsettled weather. For those of you who are working and/or involved in weekend sport, for your convenience many of the shops are open for extended hours throughout the week and weekends.

After almost two years of negotiations it has now been confirmed that Auckland Council will grant small BIDs, including Mangere Bridge, some additional funding over the next three years to replace the subsidy that we previously received from MCC. In the next financial year we will receive \$30,000 which will reduce to \$20,000 the following year then to \$15,000 for the final year. In order to maintain the level of improvements that have been achieved in the last seven years and continue to lift the profile of Mangere Bridge Village, the business association needs to look for other sources of revenue which includes the possibility to extend our BID area. We have already started up a Boutique Market every Sunday from 9am - 1pm. The reality is that without extra income the business association will cease to exist and without their oversight for maintenance and improvements to the area there is a real risk that the village could go backwards.

Please support this new boutique market and spread the word about it. Current stallholders include: Blackwood's Artisan Breads, The \$5 Deli, Gruff Junction Cheese (14 varieties), Wenvoe Foods (pickles and jams in summer and pre-packed, ready-made meals and soups in winter), The Salmon Man (fresh Salmon and scallops), Sara's Authentic Indian Cuisine (Roti Rolls, Butter Chicken and Samosa's), Sabores (South American foods, such as Empanada, and pastries), New Generation Licorice, Nuttz Gourmet, Glenbrook Lavender (a variety of products including hand creams and soaps), Devon Olives and Dipping Oils, Neelus (gourmet spices, chutneys and halwas), Ian's Wooden Toys, Dunsmuir Crafts (wooden, outdoor furniture, kitsets for raised gardens, and chopping boards etc).

Upcoming Events

Planned events include St Patrick's Day, Saturday 17 March and Food & Wine Festival Sunday 15 April, however these are dependent on the outcome of funding applications.


There were two working bees arranged for last Saturday morning. One on Waterfront reserve and one at Railway Lane Otahuhu. The object was to remove mangroves from a designated area so that James Papali'i's wakka group could carry out their first isthmus crossing event since before the motorway bridge was built .. Auckland Council had approved the work A group of a dozen Mangere Bridge residents under the guidance of Brian Pilkington managed to cut down and remove quite a big area near the motorway bridge Brian wielded a chainsaw and Kay organised a chain gang that passed the felled trees up the boulder bank. The heap will be put through a chipper shortly The Association has made a request to the Auckland Council for consent to remove all mangroves from the old bridge to Ambury Farm. We wait with baited breath! At the next meeting of the R&R it is proposed that we write to the Auckland Council seeking the approval of the proposal to reclaim all the area between the motorway Bridge and the start of the old Mangere Bridge This area is now a dead water that will soon become a complete mangrove forest. If reclaimed, the area would become a wonderful waterfront recreation area as well as providing needed parking for cars and boat trailers for people using the soon to be upgraded all tide boat ramp. What a great place for a market, or for outdoor concerts. The possibilities are huge. If you feel for or against these proposals come to the next meeting of the R&R to be held on Wednesday16th of February at the St James Church Hall at 7.30 pm


