#### Mangere Bridge Residents and Ratepayers Assoc

At our March meeting we had quite a few new faces in response to our proposal to have a working bee to remove mangrove seedlings along the Kiwi Esplanade foreshore. By the time you read this the event will be well gone, but judging from the interest, we expect a successful outcome. The meeting was dominated by the presentation of the Associations submissions to the Auckland Council Long Term Plan. We are making submissions on Council's Mangrove Management Policy and the plan to build a huge new sewage interceptor from somewhere in the Te Atatu area to the Treatment Plant at Mangere. Our Mangrove submission asks that the existing policy, set up by the previous Auckland Regional Council and adopted by the new council should be radically changed. Why should residents have to pay the council huge sums of money to obtain a resource consent to remove weeds from the harbour that council should be doing anyhow. How ridiculous, that without permission we can only remove seedlings no higher than 300mm. Recently a group got consent to remove a block of mangroves but had their approval revoked because someone had seen a protected seabird dive into the open water outside the mangrove forest. Now the group has to find \$50,000 to go to the Environment Court to try and get their consent back. As for the new interceptor, we are asking that a lot more work be done investigating the proposal. The plan is to use the huge tunnel as a holding tank to prevent sewage overflows in heavy rain conditions. During the protracted hearings on the Treatment Plant upgrade held in the late 90s we succeeded in getting a limit on the quantity of effluent being deposited in the Manukau Harbour. This limits the amount of sewage that the plant can handle. We are concerned that somewhere along the way the powers that be will say "Let's upgrade the Mangere Plant and send more sewage there as we already have the capacity in our new interceptor" Are we being unkind? Work is under way to upgrade the west side of the causeway to the old Mangere Bridge. The new footpath will project over the stone batter with several viewing bays. This will give us quite a bit more carriageway some of which was pinched from the other side when the cycleway was built. The all tide ramp upgrade is about to start (I've been saying that for three months!) Our next meeting is to be held on Wednesday 18 April at the St James Church Hall at 7.30PM. Come along and get this info first hand. Bill Kirk. MBR&R Assoc

In the past month of march we have been involved in Shrove Tuesday which was held in Papatoetoe selling candyfloss to raise funds.


