Our long awaiting all-tide boat ramp has been further delayed. The design was changed from the one that was originally approved through the various public meetings held a number of years ago. The redesign is felt by many to be unsafe and Jim Jackson of Jackson Electrical, who has boated on the Manukau Harbour since he was a small boy, has put forward another proposal which would also allow space for rescue craft, plus ferry facilities for the longer term. However, in the meantime the New Zealand Transport Authority (NZTA) has been advised that the old pedestriand cycle bridge, which is a vital link between the communities of Mangere Bridge and Onehunga, has deteriorated to such a stage that it will have to be replaced within the next five years. The NZTA met with key stakeholders recently to give this update and to advise that following a mailbox drop to both communities in late July they would be running some Open Days to consult with the public. No concept designs will be started until after public consultation. It would make sense to combine the building of the new hoat ramp with the replacement pedestrian. boat ramp with the replacement pedestrian bridge and hopefully we will come out with a win/win situation all round.

July has been a busy month. Two issues have been followed through with mixed success. Firstly the question of rocks left on the sea bed when the oxidation ponds were removed. The Treatment Plant Community Liaison Group chaired by Colin Dale, on which we have three members, Roger Baldwin, Ken Duff and Brian Pilkington met with Watercare senior officers on the foreshore near the Oruarangi Creek entrance. There was a low tide, so the rocks were clearly visible where the pond dividing wall had been located. The residents spokesperson spoke about the pre ponds era when folk used to flounder fish in the rock free area. Watercare acknowledged that the rocks were remnants of the wall but felt the cost of their removal would be better spent on improvement to the sewage system to prevent overflows in residential areas They agreed to record the situation so that future generations wouldn't think the rocks were always there. Watercare still "own" the seabed, and will give some thought as to when their jurisdiction of the old ponds area will be relinquished. Secondly, the ongoing delays in the plans to make the all tide ramp safer and more user friendly facility were discussed by some forty interested parties at a meeting on the 18th of the month. We were quite surprised to be told by a planner from NZ Transport Authority (previously Transit NZ) that they were planning to remove the old Mangere Bridge and replace it

with a footbridge. There would be public consultations startng soon. Happy hundred year birthday old bridge! So with a new bridge, hopefully high enough for boats to go through, there are already suggestions that the new ramp should be on the inner side of the causeway. The unfinished look of the rock work on Kiwi Esplanade foreshore is still a concern with the Association. Residents will be able to have their say at the R&R Annual General Meeting to be held at the Mangere Bridge School Hall on Wednesday 22nd of August at 7.30PM. We hope you will attend and support your Association by giving us a \$5 membership fee at the door. (voluntary)
