Mangere Historical Society

Mangere Historical Society has been kept busy with interesting speakers and trips away to places of interest. A walk around Crater hill and lagoon on Self's old farmland educated those there, about volcanoes and the creation of tuft cones which showed clearly the ash, sediment and stone layers created by various long ago explosions of volcanoes from as far away as Taupo. On to Pukaki another similar place, to look at the area that had once been George Hennings Speedway and now provided peaceful grazing for farm stock.

Back to the Archives room at the Town Centre for time to browse the information on display and enjoy their lunch and a welcome cuppa.

A bus load headed off to the Helensville Historical Village one Wednesday and their memories were stirred as the members wandered around the houses, court room and farm barn displaying so many exhibits that we all recognised from our Grandparents homes and maybe our own!

Our speaker this month was Kelly Douglas from Auckland City Mission and she enlightened us on the multifaceted work that is undertaken by the people there. Herne Bay House catering for HIV and Aids victims, Whitley House at Campbells Bay caring for elderly people convalescing, to food parcels, presents and Christmas Dinner for thousands, help for homeless people, Medical and Dental Clinics, Detox centre, Herne Bay House catering for HIV and Aids victims, and so much more. She told of the early history of Rev Jasper Calder who had such a concern for the needy poor of Auckland through to the present Missioner Diane Robertson CEO at Selwyn Foundation which houses 650 people as well and catering for so many others in need through furniture distribution and advocacy services and so much else. We were enlightened to hear of the magnificent work undertaken on a very tight budget, contributed by donations from a number of interested and concerned people.

The challenge of finding data about the Roll of Honour names in the War Memorial Hall continues with hard won success. Slowly the people's data is recorded and photos collect where possible.

There is so much to learn by joining the friendly members of Mangere Historical Society.
