Mangere Bridge Residents and Ratepayers

The first meeting of the year was well attended with 30 residents. The meeting was pleased to have the attendance of one of our councillors, Alf Filipaina who spent some time discussing Mangere matters. He had spent some time with officials over the proposed Central Interceptor. He supported our objections to this out dated and expensive way of dealing with combined sewer and stormwater disposal. He would support the application from the Ratepayers for the total reclamation of the area between the Motorway bridge and the old Mangere Bridge. Several members had attended the Local Board's meeting at the War Memorial Hall that had been called to listen to residents suggestions for projects for the next three years. One written suggestion was for the Board to support the long proposed suggestion that the area between the bridges be reclaimed. With the opening of the new boat ramp there was going to be a need for more parking, and the demolition of the old Mangere Bridge would provide a huge amount of solid fill. A circular about aircraft noise was circulated at that meeting. This notice included Mangere Bridge as an area that suffered from overseas aircraft noise. There was no support from that meeting. The matter was discussed at our meeting, and it was resolved we write to the authors of the circular saying that as there was only isolated complaints about airline noise in Mangere Bridge, we ask that Mangere Bridge be not mentioned as a suburb affect by airline noise in any further public statements or circulars put out by that organisation. Mr Filipaina was thanked for his attendance and it was hoped he would visit us monthly. It was noted that a letter had not been sent to Airways Corporation suggesting that Barrier Airlines that regularly circles our area awaiting a landing clearance should be required to overfly the airport and hold to the south in the harbour area. This letter would be sent. Carol Anne Armitage, the Village Manager, showed the meeting the various proposals for the intensified housing in the Mangere Bridge area. Objections to the plans can still be made. Forms at the library. Ken Duff spoke about the Central Interceptor proposal. Letters had been sent by the R&R and Manukau Harbour Restoration Society to the Minister for the Environment seeking an enquiry into the hearings process where Auckland Council appointed and paid the commissioners to hear objections to its own project. It was noted that work appears to have started on the new road to Puketutu Island. A new road is needed as Watercare intend to extend the Treatment plant to the south of the present road that runs beside the plant. It appears that the new road will start midway between Ascot Rd and the present start of the road. The new Local Board has decided their monthly meetings will now be held on the third Wednesday of each month starting at 5 pm. As this will clash with our meeting it was decided that our meetings would be held on the second Wednesday of each month. Brian Very, a local resident wood sculptor showed us a work in progress. He is working on the carving at the Sunday Market in the Village. The carving covers many factors of life in Mangere Bridge. The finished work will be raffled, and proceeds will go towards costs of resource consents for mangrove removal in our area. The next meeting will be on Wednesday 12 March at the St James Church Hall at 7.30pm
