Mangere Bridge Residents and Ratepayers

The December meeting was attended by twenty members. An interesting letter from NZ Transport Authority stated that the restrictive designation between the old bridge and the motorway bridges would be revoked, but that NZTA would not change their plan to terminate the Mangere end of the new footbridge right beside the new boat tramp. After some discussion it was resolved that we write to Auckland Council asking them to make application to reclaim sufficient seabed adjacent to the end of the causeway so that there would be a new area for the Mangere end of the new footbridge, thus keeping it away from the busy boat ramp It would also provide parking for cars and boat trailers as the causeway is often fully occupied with boat trailers and will become very congested as the years go by. With all the proposals for tunnelling in the region, the area between the bridges would be a prime location for disposal of the excavated material. (second half of the SH2O Waterview tunnel, and Watercare's huge tunnel from Western Springs to the Treatment Plant at Mangere).

The Local Board member spoke of the activities the Board had been involved with. He advised that with the grade separation of George Bolt Memorial Drive and Kirkbride Rd., the Bader Drive off ramp would be retained. When it was built it was stated that it would be closed should grade separation take place. Mark Erskine spoke about the need for the RMA to be modified so that mangroves can be removed without consent fees. The meeting concluded with a nice supper provided by the ladies of the committee. Since the meeting it is great to see that our Chair, Val Payne was recognised in the New Years Honours list with The Queens Service Medal for service to the community. Our congratulation to you Val. There was no meeting in January so our next meeting is Tuesday February 10th at St James Church hall at 7.30pm.
