Mangere Bridge Residents and Ratepayers

Mangere Bridge Residents and Ratepayers are people with an overwhelming concern for their area and neighbours, and come out in the most inclement to express their concerns and learn of advances regarding other matters brought up previously.

High on the list of concerns was the possibility of the lifting of the liquor ban in Mangere's parks and foreshore. Those who live close by any of these places remarked on the considerable improvement that all experienced once the ban was in place, and they were very definitely against any idea of lifting something that was working reasonably well.

Mangere Bridge Business Manager's report was received and it was noted that the CCTV cameras will be needing to be replaced with more up to date models very soon. Approx. \$50.000.00 is the required cost to keep an eye on our business area. No small amount for a friendly village to raise.

The East-West Transport Auckland Plan was discussed. Not really acceptable to those who attended the Meeting called in Onehunga a few weeks earlier. There appears to be no access to the wharf that we hope will be redesigned for other uses in the future. No obvious way for people to walk the old bridge and use the new footbridge to get to Onehunga. A spaghetti junction of loops on ground that is not available to use in this way, it was suggested. Rail should also be shown on these plans.

It was noted that a small area of mangroves has started to be removed near the off ramp at Mangere Bridge. We were informed that because the Council has the over-riding debt, they have denied our Local Board the use of the half million dollars that had been set aside for this project, and the 23 hectares that was to be removed along the foreshore, has been cut back to 7.6 hectares. It is understood that a helicopter has to be used to remove the debris and this cuts back the finances tremendously. The way the residents did it manually was certainly a much cheaper option, although a lot muddier!

The supposed redesignation of two top paddocks of Ambury Farm is erroneous and nothing is decided as yet. Sorry for the incorrect information.

Discussion on our Councillors remarks regarding the big jump in rates being the equivalent to a cup of coffee, was regarded with scorn, as we all know that when you are on a fixed income such as a pension, benefit etc no-one allows \$4.95 and up for a coffee when you can make your own when you get home. Bringing up a family gets increasingly more expensive and living in Mangere is no longer considered a cheap suburb in which to live for anyone.
