Mangere Historical Society

Mangere Historical Society celebrated the launching of their latest book recording the names and brief service histories of the Mangere District ANZAC men and women from World War II.

Several of the Members have dedicated 4-5 years researching all the names on the Roll of Honour in the War Memorial Hall.

They had to discover the Christian names as there were only initials shown. They asked for birth dates and which service they served in, where they were deployed and other relevant data.

They were delighted when pictures were scanned and offered as this put some flesh to the names and information that had been gleaned.

At the 2015 ANZAC service in the War Memorial Hall, Val Payne spoke briefly of the research and several people approached her, remarking that it sounded very interesting and they would like to know more.
