Mangere Bridge Community Newsletter

Speed is the single biggest road safety issue in New Zealand today.

In the wider Mangere community 98 people were injured and 8 were killed by speed related crashes from 2011 to 2015*.

The faster you drive the worse any injuries are likely to be. A pedestrian hit at 70 km/h has a 96% chance of dying, compared with a 40% chance at 50 km/h and only 5% at 30 km/h*.

Being part of a community is looking after each other. Driving at a safe speed for the conditions means you are less likely to cause injury to yourself or someone else.

Let's tackle speeding together by driving at a safe speed for every person around us. Our community hero's, schools and childcare centres have got together to help change our culture of speeding.

Everyone has a story. Have you done your's yet?

Marie Clark was the speaker at Mangere Historical Society and spoke of her involvement in Mangere since she and her husband Colin first came to live in Hall Ave as a newly married couple. She and her electrician husband Colin were involved in the original group who started the CAB in Mangere and watched it flourish and multiply into the Law Centre and Budget Advice etc. David Lange had been in one of Colin's Sunday School classes and he had requested Colin to become a J.P. which he did. Marie and Colin also became Industrial Chaplains to the Staff at Air N.Z through the devastating time of the Erebus Crash. They were both Sunday School teachers and Lay Preachers in the Mangere Methodist Church and Parish. They became Celebrants and were invited to take many weddings, naming ceremonies and funerals. They joined the Servas people who hosted overseas visitors in the family homes, and they enjoyed many international people staying with them. They were also able to do the same when they travelled overseas. Colin used his electrical skills on Missions to Solomon Islands and Papua New Guinea. Marie has had a very full and interesting life and shared much of it helping the people of Mangere. These are the people who help make Mangere Bridge the lovely place that it is to live in.
