Speed is the single biggest road safety issue in New Zealand today.

In the wider Mangere community 98 people were injured and 8 were killed by speed related crashes from 2011 to 2015*.

The faster you drive the worse any injuries are likely to be. A pedestrian hit at 70 km/h has a 96% chance of dying, compared with a 40% chance at 50 km/h and only 5% at 30 km/h*.

Being part of a community is looking after each other. Driving at a safe speed for the conditions means you are less likely to cause injury to yourself or someone else.

Let's tackle speeding together by driving at a safe speed for every person around us. Our community hero's, schools and childcare centres have got together to help change our culture of speeding.

Mangere Historical Society learns about Zimbabwe

Our speaker, Sue Waldmeyer, is one of our Mangere Bridge Librarians, who started life far from here. She was born and grew up in Zimbabwe and shared her stories and pictures of this country so far from N.Z. Zimbabwe is in the Tropics but because of high elevation it enjoys a sub-tropical climate. It has dramatic landscapes and vast areas that are cultivated for wheat, maize and tobacco. Brahmin cattle were shown grazing on pasture land in one picture. Sue described briefly the history of this area, starting with the British South Africa Co governing from 1890-1923. It then became the Federation of Rhodesia and Nyasaland governed until 1979 when the name Zimbabwe was accepted.

From 1980 to the present day Zimbabwe, under President Robert Mugabe, became a country that many people opted to leave. There appears to be a different history taught in the schools these days from that learned by Sue. The Capital Harare has 1.5 million people, several languages are spoken Ndebele, English, Shona and many currencies are acceptable. This landlocked country has several neighbours, Zambia, Botswana, Mozambique and South Africa.

The roads in the country areas have only two strips of tar seal which require road courtesy when you met oncoming traffic, as each vehicle moves across to use just one strip each as they pass. Huge barns with big vents in the roof are used for drying the tobacco and the older version with thatched roof and open sides showed the early and slower method of accomplishing this task. The many rivers offered good irrigation for many farmers using canals, and sugar cane is grown. The magnificent Victoria Falls are the focus for many tourists and their photos.

We were reminded that one man's terrorist is another's freedom fighter.
