

Mangere Bridge has another resident who recently launched a book. Evie Mahoney has written a book called "What does the sea sound like?". It is based on her experience as a CODA, a Child of Deaf Adults.

The book was launched at the Auckland Deaf Society with the help of a sign language interpreter for the Deaf. Evie spoke about her family of six hearing children raised by profoundly deaf parents in Auckland. The book is about her deaf culture, the importance of communication and the valuable significance of learning NZ sign language. She was inspired by her parents with their perception of the hearing world which differed from their hearing children, and is proud to write about their achievements.
