New Foot Bridge to Onehunga

Mangere Bridge residents may not be aware that the new footbridge to be built to replace the old Mangere Bridge has been put on the back burner for a while. It will now be done when the East West Connection is constructed. Several years away.

I have asked Auckland Council and NZTA to think about making the walkway into a traffic bridge that would terminate on the Onehunga foreshore where an extension of Galway Street is planned to join the EW Link. After all, we had our direct connection to Onehunga before the motorway cut it off. Now a five minute journey can take fifteen minutes. Auckland Council have said we must continue using the motorway, and NZTA say they will only build a footbridge.
