## Mangere Historical Society

The members of Mangere Historical Society had a split meeting. The Business side was conducted in the Hall on Church Rd and then those who were interested, drove over to Alfred St Onehunga, to the Railway Enthusiasts Society Club rooms, set in the original Onehunga Station Building. This is the only original one of its class left in New Zealand. It has all its walls displaying photos of trains, engine plaque numbers, bridges, and rail destinations, as well as the well remembered heavy tea cups that were filled at Te Kuiti, National Park or Taumaranui with a liquid you could almost stand your spoon up in. The Railways Enthusiasts are also responsible for the Glenbrook Railway runing to Waiuku. Martin Clapham,our host there, remarked how expensive it is to run the Train excursions that were so popular to many places in New Zeasland. Their railway drivers are not licensed to drive on the Main Line and the number of steam train drivers is thinning out rapidly. Their Glenbrook engines require extensive replacement work and they have closed early this year to allow this to be undertaken. The Rooms at the bottom of Alfred St are open 9-12 Monday to Saturday and a great place to visit if you are interested in this form of travel.

of their rights and responsibilities and that their local and national communities are responsibly developed.


