Santa Parade

Despite heavy rain and thunder earlier in the day, the weather was fine and mild for the annual Santa Parade. With flashing lights and sirens blaring, the police patrol car announced the start of the parade at 6.30pm sharp, followed by the City of Manukau Pipes and Drums. The crowds lining the footpaths enjoyed watching over 40 floats as they slowly made their way down one side of Coronation Road and back up the other.

Participating groups this year included a variety of vintage cars, American Field Ambulance, jeeps and speedway cars, Manukau City Parks, Ambury Farm Park, Papakura Coastguard, Mangere Bridge Yacht Club, Cook Island Dance group, Kiwi Bank car, Lions Club, St John Youth Division, Mangere Bridge Play Centre, St Anthony's Church, SPCA Dog Squad, Variety Book Bus and Super Value. These were interspersed by groups representing Mangere Bridge Walking Group, the Mangere Mountain Education Centre, Mangere Bridge Primary School, Cubs and Keas, Walking School Buses, the Mangere Bridge Pony Cub plus Jiggles the Clown.

The always popular Bananas in Pajamas, with their friends Puss 'n Boots and Donkey, Po and Laa-Laa, Bat Man and Robin, Darth Vader, Tin Man, Penguin and Bob the Builder boogied their way along the parade route giving an impromptu dance routine with their mini P.A. system and posing for photographs along the way. Bringing up the rear was Santa himself, this year aided by two of his elves who helped him hand out lollies afterwards.

With the miniature train out of action for repairs this year a red, double decked, bus carried parents and children from Mangere Bridge Plunket and was kept busy afterwards giving free rides. There were also queues for Pony and Cart rides, The Puppet Man, face painting and Bouncy Castles.

There was plenty to see with a variety of stalls and the crowd didn't go hungry with Mangere Bridge Scouts and Kindergarten running sausage sizzles, plus French Crepes, takeaway shops and cafes. As the crowds thinned those who remained were treated to some great entertainment from the Frank E. Evans Band.

DOWN ON THE FARM- AMBURY FARM THAT IS!

Summer is approaching and the animals are thankful for any shade or shelter they have in their paddocks. Most of the lambs are weaned now and are starting to put on weight. Charlotte, the new sow, is expecting piglets by mid December, so make your way down and check them out once they have arrived.

Along the Watercare Coastal walkway the NZ dotterels are busy making nests and laying eggs, please take care near these as a few have already been disturbed by predators. There has been a sighting of three young chicks but as this is a dangerous time for newborn we are hoping they will survive. Please be a responsible dog or cat owner. Keep all dogs out of the area and if possible please lock cats in for the night if you live close to the park or watercare. Report any concerns to either the Mangere Treatment Plant or the Ambury Ranger.

During the summer months the park gates are locked at 8.30 so come on down for a nice summer BBQ - use your own or one of the park ones. Bring a ball or bike and enjoy the lovely summer evenings in this beautiful park.

As we are heading towards Christmas now is the time to spend an hour or so planning your security requirements

The holiday period brings different challenges for different businesses. Some firms have extended shut down periods, others are running extra shifts and carry additional materials and stock. In both cases the security risks are considerably heightened.

Icon Security recommends the following:

Check your emergency call out/contact list with your monitoring company and ensure that the staff listed will be contactable and able to respond

Make arrangements to remove or secure valuable stock and equipment such as laptops, projectors etc over the holiday period (ensure not left visible through windows)

Ensure that loose materials and stocks are not left unsecured on the on the property even when in a fenced area (this becomes attractive to cut the fence)

Conduct a walk through audit of your business to ensure external lights, fences and gates are in good working condition, locks are appropriate for use and that the alarm systems have been serviced and checked.

Consider contracting ICON Group to provide random security patrols whilst the business is shut down or to conduct welfare checks on staff working night shifts.
