
Icon Security Group

It is disappointing to note this month that there has been a spate of break-ins on fast food premises. The offenders are targeting cash floats left in the tills and are safe in the knowledge that the business concerned has no alarms and minimal security measures.

As we have mentioned in previous reports, we strongly recommend that all businesses invest in an alarm system and have it monitored. Basic alarm packages start at around \$500 and together with prominent security signage and a nominated response company provide a very good deterrent. We would also recomment that all cash is removed offsite or at least to a safe and that tills are left open after house.

On a more positive note, the ICON Group Security patrols were recently involved in the successful apprehension of local taggers and ICON Group will be providing security at the forthcoming Autumn Festival.

Mangere Historical Society – archeology lesson

Our speaker at St James Church Hall on Tuesday 16th March was Barry Barquie. He is a self employed archeologist who has been working on the area around Albert Park, beside the Art Gallery. There has been the demolition of part of the building and new extensions taking place. Several pieces of history were uncovered by the big digging machinery. A portion of the wall from

A portion of the wall from the days of the Albert Barracks, a midden from the Maori occupation, broken crockery from the time of the early soldiers stationed there, concrete ornamentation from pillars used on the outside of the building were all displayed on a screen.

This made it easy to see just what he was meant as he described each find. He had a detailed map of the four miles of tunneling under Albert Park and this stirred memories amongst some of our members, of entering these in their younger days. This was truly a look at the past of Auckland City through the years.

The president and Secretary attended the Federation of Historical Societies Conference, hosted by the West Auckland Society at Henderson, Huia, Whatipu and Titirangi. This is an area not so well known to the Mangere reps and they enjoyed their learning experience wandering around the wonderful Huia Museum, listening to some of the history of the Watipu locality and mingling with other like minded folk.

The Historical Society at Mangere Bridge is growing in numbers each meeting. We welcome every-body to come and listen to our speakers,

contribute their knowledge and enjoy meeting other people. The next meeting is to take place At St James Church Hall, Church Road Mangere Bridge at 1.30pm on April 20th. The speaker will be Stan Ansell speaking about War Stories. See you there.
